PROGRAM NOTE

Imagine arriving at Fair Isle between Scotland and Norway, a remote island where shipwrecks and rare birds exist, as you breathe in the tranquility of an older time. *Fair Isle Walkabout* musically transports your mind to this idyllic location, with A Dorian, mixed meters-2/4 and 4/4, 2- and 3-part writing and the feeling of motion from the movement of the melody and sweeping dynamics by each instrument of the orchestra. Sue Roberts Sharp magically inspires young people's imaginations and musicality through her *Fair Isle Walkabout* at a Level 2.
